
So, as I close - sigh! - I thank my God for you and I love you dearly. I pray I have shown that, and responded to all things with love.

Considering that residents make around 50 cents an hour, it was an amazing sacrifice by him. His gift brings to mind Luke 21:1-4 where the widow puts in a couple of copper coins:

"He looked up and saw rich people putting their gifts into the treasury; he also saw a poor widow put in two small copper coins. He said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put in more than all of them; for all of them have contributed out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty has put in all she had to live on."
